3. Minimum 5 years in aviation safety investigations of aircraft accidents in accordance with ICAO Annex 13 Standards and Recommended Practices.
4. Formal Training in Management and Leadership
5. Comprehensive understanding of the PNG aviation framework, and operational environment, including national and international aviation safety systems, relevant conventions, and applicable legislation governing aviation safety investigation.
6. Demonstrated ability to work effectively both independently and within multidisciplinary investigation teams, including leadership capability to manage investigative tasks, set objectives, supervise team activities, and report on investigation outcomes.
7. Strong analytical, research, and problem-solving skills with the ability to assess technical evidence and provide professional advice relating to aviation safety investigations.
8. Demonstrated high standards of integrity, professionalism, and ethical conduct, with a commitment to impartiality and responsible handling of sensitive investigation information.
9. Excellent oral and written communication skills, including the ability to prepare clear, concise, and technically accurate investigation reports, and to liaise effectively with stakeholders from diverse professional and cultural backgrounds.
10. High-level proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Outlook).
11. Strong Knowledge of safety management system assessment.
